All materials must be received before the application is reviewed. Please submit the following:

- ASHA Letter of Good Standing:** The applicant must contact ASHA to have a formal letter attesting to current certification standing sent on letterhead directly to CASLPA.
- Official Graduate Transcripts:** The applicant must contact their university and have their official graduate transcripts stating Degree Conferred and date sent directly to CASLPA. Only originals and transcripts stating Degree Conferred and date will be accepted.
- Clinical Hours Forms:** The applicant must submit their university clinical practicum hours. We require all applicants to submit a completed [CASLPA Summary of Clinical Practicum Hours form](#). If your university used a different form please transfer the hours to the CASLPA form and submit with your university form.
- CASLPA membership application:** The applicant must complete either an [electronic or paper membership application](#) with the appropriate fees.

All applicants must meet CASLPA clinical certification coursework and clinical hour requirements before they are approved.

- Possess at least a Master's Degree in (Audiology or equivalent);
- Course work must meet the following minimum hours:
 - 270 hours in normal development and use of speech, language and hearing;
 - 360 hours in audiology; and
 - 90 hours in speech-language pathology.
- 350 hours of supervised clinical practicum as described for audiologists in audiology clinical hours (including 20 hours in speech-language pathology).

To maintain CASLPA clinical certification you will be required to:

- Collect 45 continuing education equivalents (CEEs) in each three-year cycle;
- Report CEEs annually by January 31; and
- Renew CASLPA membership annually.
