This CD contains the following materials: *Australian Journal of Audiology* (1978-1998); *Australian and New Zealand Journal of Audiology* (1999-2006); *Journal of Audiological Medicine* (1992-2002); *Journal of the Academy of Rehabilitative Audiology* (1969-2003); Commonwealth Acoustic Laboratories Reports (Australian, 1948-1979); National Acoustic Laboratories Reports (Australian, 1975-1981); Commonwealth and National Acoustic Laboratories Internal Reports (Australian, 1963-1984); Vanderbilt/VA Hearing Aid Report (1981); Vanderbilt/VA Hearing Aid Report II (1991), selected articles from *The Hearing Journal* (1990-1998), and hearing related articles from the *Journal of Rehabilitation Research and Development* (Department of Veterans Affairs). Also included is Issue #3, from *International Audiology* (1965), which inadvertently was omitted when the *International Audiology* journals were put on CD-ROM Set #4 (see below). Please note that Issue #3, Volume 2, 1969, *Journal of the Academy of Rehabilitative Audiology* was not published.

Many of the materials on the CD-ROM came from the library in our research laboratory with major contributions from Dafydd Stephens, Linda Luxon, and Colin Whurr (*Journal of Audiological Medicine*); the Audiological Society of Australia (Monica Persson); the Canadian Audiology, Speech Language Pathology Association (Angie Friend); the Australian National Acoustic Laboratories (Joy Fischer); Jill Preminger, Laura Ann Wilber, Christina Roup, Carol DeFilippo, and Linda M. Each year of the journals is stored in a folder, within which each issue of the journal is stored in a sub-folder with a table of contents for that issue. For each journal there is a "Tables of Contents" file that contains all of the tables of contents for that particular journal compiled into one file. Each article is stored by the last names of the first three authors, followed by the abbreviation of the journal, and the year of publication. For most efficient use, the materials should be copied to your hard drive (or server). The main folder, the year folder, or any of the sub-folders can be searched by author or year by "right clicking" on the folder then "left clicking" on "search" on the pull-down menu.

Finally, a folder entitled, "Tables of Contents for Audiology Related Articles" is included. This folder contains searchable files of the tables of contents of articles of interest to audiologists that were distilled mostly from the listings on PubMed. The gamut of the audiology literature from 24 journals is included, ranging from *Acta Otolaryngologica*, to *Ear and Hearing*, to the *Journal of the American Academy of Audiology*, to the *Journal of the Acoustical Society of America*.

If you find this e-library concept useful in your professional pursuits, then take a few minutes to urge other professional organizations to make their libraries available in a similar format. A limited number of these CD-ROM sets are available.
