

STUDENT EXCELLENCE AWARD: PEER NOMINATION FORM



Awarded to a CASLPA student member, in their graduating year of study, in each of the communication disorders (speech-language pathology and audiology) university programs in Canada, who is **determined to be the best all-round future professional**. Winners are provided complimentary registration for the CASLPA conference.

Selection is based on a peer nomination process with student recommendations forwarded to Student Reps. Names of the three most nominated individuals are presented to university faculty advisors who are responsible for choosing the final winner based on clinical ratings, leadership qualities and grade point average. One faculty advisor must sign and submit a nomination form for each student which contains sufficient documentation to confirm the candidate's qualifications and clinical grades (official transcripts are not required), as well as a copy of the student's curriculum vitae.

Please take a moment to consider your fellow **CASLPA student members** who have shown great enthusiasm for the study of audiology and/or speech-language pathology, and whose dedication has inspired others to contribute to the growth of the profession.
